

Lick Springs Fence Enclosure Project Open for Bid

*Beatys Butte, Harney County
42.30055, -119.30928*



The Harney Soil and Water Conservation District is accepting bids on a spring protection fence enclosure project. The project will include the removal of existing fencing and the installation of heavy replacement pipe fencing, wire fence, and two metal gates.

The SWCD proposal includes:

- 1) Removal of the approximately 350 feet of existing enclosure fence around the spring site.
- 2) Installation of 620 feet of pipe fencing for an improved spring enclosure. The fence design will follow the NRCS wildlife-friendly design. The fence will be a three-rail design, with the top rail lowered to no more than 42 inches in height, and the bottom rail raised to 16 inches off the ground.
- 3) Install two 12-foot metal corner swing gates for the enclosure for entrapped animals to escape. Gates are to be placed at the lower and upper ends of the drainage enclosure. (NE and NW Corners)
- 4) Install a 40-foot wire fence on the upper slope side of the boundary to prevent livestock from accessing the spring from the top. The wire fence will follow the NRCS wildlife-friendly design. The fence will be a three-wire design, with the top wire lowered to no more than 42 inches in height, and the bottom wire raised to 16 inches off the ground. Barbed wire is an acceptable material.

There will be a mandatory bid tour on **July 8, 2026 7:30 am** (Attached map). **A representative from your company must be present in person for the bid tour.** Bids are due either by hand delivery or by email no later than **July 17, 2026 4:00 pm**. All work must be completed by **October 30 2027**. 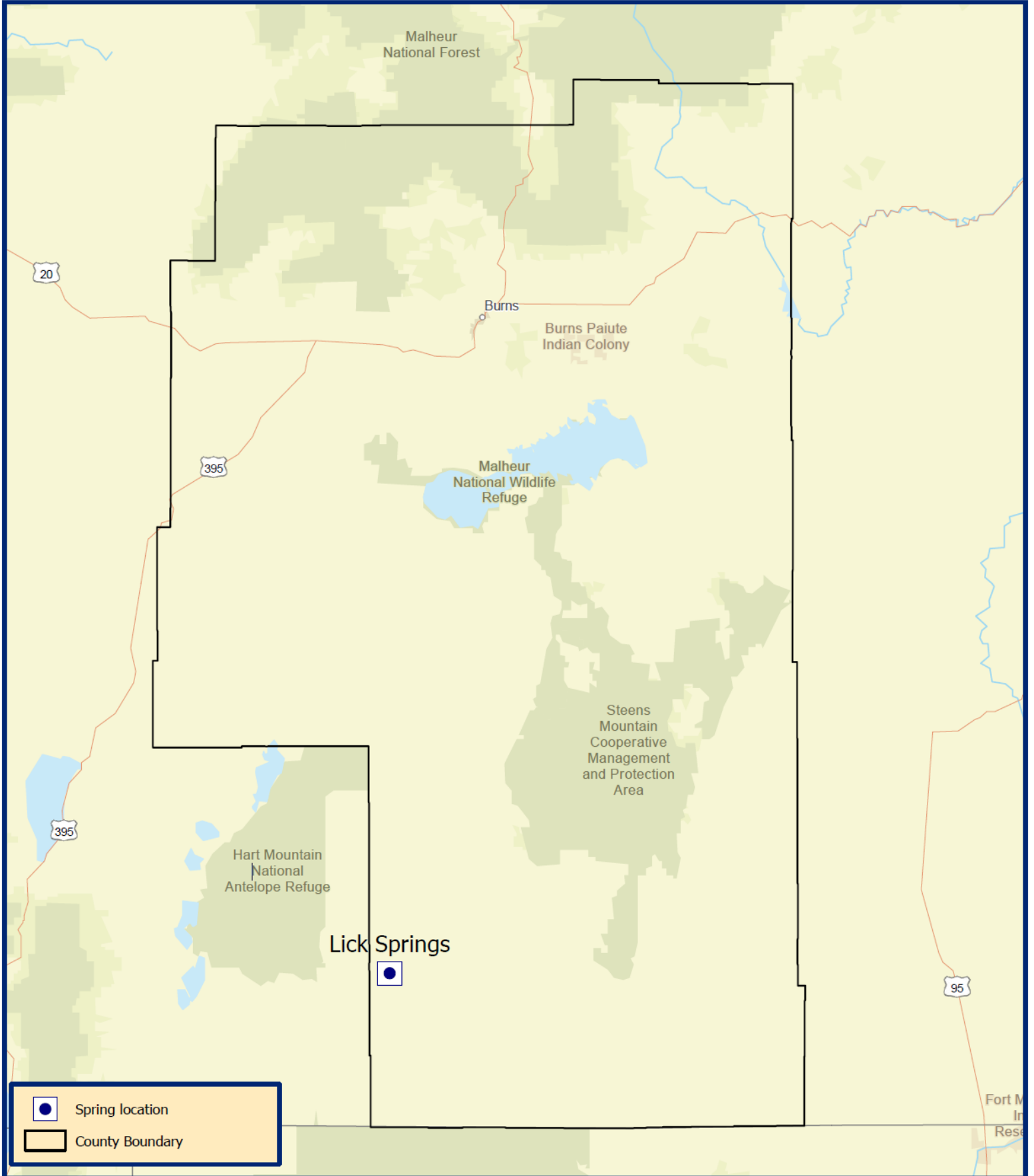

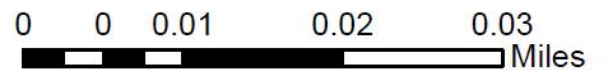
